


# Welcome to Ibaraki Port!

Ibaraki Port is located 100 km northeast of Tokyo, in the middle of Ibaraki Prefecture. The port is used as sea gateways for the Northern Kanto area.

It is about 320km away, 12 to 16 hours, from Tokyo Bay by ship.

## Oarai District, Ibaraki Port (Wharf No.4)

- Wharf Length: 240m
- Depth: -8m

- Parking capacity of 50 buses
- Water Supply Capacity 45t/h×4

## Hitachinaka District, Ibaraki Port (Central Wharf)

- Wharf Length:  
Berth C 300m  
Berth D 300m
- Depth: -12m

- Water Supply Capacity 28t/h×4
- Direct access to the Kita-Kanto Expressway
